Yuma County 4-H Council

Applicants must be between the ages of 12 and 18 as of December 31, 2024, to apply and they must also be enrolled in 4-H at the time of application. Successful catchers must have adequate facilities available to house their steer as they are responsible for the care, feeding, and handling of their animal. 
