2025 KCC 4-H Shooting Sports Schedule

All 4-H Youth participating in shooting sports must follow the county Shooting Sports Participation Policy. A copy of the policy will be provided at the time of 4-H enrollment and will be available online or in print at the Extension office.

Shooting Sports Safety Training (MANDATORY) – March 23, 2025

This training is **mandatory for all 4-H members** enrolled in the 4-H Shooting Sports project and will be held at the Burlington Gun Club Clubhouse. A general safety training will be done, and members will get acquainted with coaches. Discipline specific safety items will be presented at discipline trainings.

There will not be another Safety Training offered other than this one.

Gun Club Workday – March 23, 2025

In conjunction with the safety training at Burlington Gun Club, members will need to bring gloves rakes, shovels etc. to clean up at the gun club. We will provide trash bags!

Discipline Training Dates (REQUIRED) – April 13, 2025 (See time schedule below)

Our state certified 4-H leaders in each shooting discipline will go over: 1) Discipline specific safety rules, safe firearm & bow handling and range safety rules. 2) Range commands for their range. 3) Basic shooting techniques and shooting positions. 4) Basic care for sporting arms and bows. 5) Proper ammunition or types of arrows for each discipline.
